About the NMT Case-based Training Series

The NMT Case-based Training Series is a clinical case conference series led by Dr. Bruce Perry and attended by participants via the Internet. Over the last decade, The ChildTrauma Academy has offered a variety of web-based teaching experiences, typically using clinical cases as the primary teaching vehicle. This current offering is the latest addition to our catalog of teaching series.

The focus of this unique 12-session series will be treatment planning and intervention using the NMT as a guiding framework. Senior clinicians will present a client (four different clients will be presented and followed over the course of the year), formulate a treatment plan and then, over the next months (varying from 9 to 11 months) we will be able to track the progress of the ongoing treatment. In contrast to previous NMT Case-based series, there will be a more in depth focus on actual treatment planning and delivery of intervention – with an opportunity to track the ongoing treatment process.

The Neurosequential Model of Therapeutics is an evidence-based practice (EPB) that is both “trauma-informed” and developmentally sensitive. The NMT is a clinical problem-solving approach that includes an assessment process intended to help select and sequent a set of developmentally appropriate (and age-acceptable) therapeutic, educational and enrichment activities that match the specific strengths and needs of the client. This framework complements other clinical approaches and “encourages” appropriate use of a wide range of specific clinical and therapeutic activities.

The case-based teaching model has been useful for helping clinicians and frontline staff better understand the neurodevelopmental principles involved in many of the primary symptoms, as well as strengths, they see in the children they serve. NMT trainings provide an opportunity for ongoing capacity building within an institution or for individuals. We recommend this series as a complement to any more intensive training/program development projects that our partners have with the CTA. However, individual and institutional participation does not require any other program development activities or projects with the CTA and can serve as a good introduction to viewing maltreated and traumatized children through the “lens” of neurodevelopment.

PARTICIPATION OPTIONS & FEES

There are two options for GROUP/ORGANIZATION participation:

Live Organization with Recordings - \$2000 USD per site

Recordings Only Organization - \$ 1800 USD per site

A group participating LIVE may include up to 25 persons but all must assemble in a single room with a single computer and phone connection into the conference. Each additional location/site requires an additional subscription. Groups participating LIVE also receive online access to recordings of each session which will be accessible for 18 months from the date of enrollment. A group participating via Recordings Only may be as large as 25 participants assembled in a single room. Additional participants require additional subscription fees.

There are three options for INDIVIDUAL participation:

Live Individual - \$750 USD

Live Individual with Recordings - \$850 USD

Recordings Only Individual - \$500 USD

HOW IT WORKS

Participants joining LIVE will receive invitations via email to each of the twelve sessions. Sessions take place via the Internet with audio provided via telephone. Invitations include a link and instructions to gain entry to each session. All sessions must be purchased in this 12-set package. No refunds or make-up sessions will be conducted for those LIVE participants who do not participate in any particular session; those wanting access to any recordings of any session must purchase the LIVE with RECORDINGS option.

Participants joining via RECORDINGS ONLY may view recordings of the live sessions at any time, from any computer. Participants receiving RECORDINGS will receive a User Name and password to access recordings of each session as well as the related case abstract and brain map to review prior to listening to each session. Organizations participating in RECORDINGS ONLY will select a single point person to access and play recordings for their group. All recordings may be paused, restarted and replayed. All twelve recordings in this series will be available for 18 months from enrollment date.
