She is the founder and former director of a non-governmental organisation, CASE (Community Action towards a Safer Environment) based in Hanover Park, one of the most violent communities in South Africa. Having worked with victims and perpetrators of violence in the TRC and at the Trauma Centre more than 15 years ago, Lane sought to develop knowledge from the ground and make psychology practice more accessible and inclusive for oppressed South African communities.

As a psychologist, her passion is in facilitating processes of healing through working alongside diverse individuals and communities in order to address issues of violence and trauma within a context of extreme poverty, inequality and injustice. In 2015 she started CASE Connect which is a consultancy aimed at creating a trauma-informed society.
