Tony Bloemendaal is a consultant, Clinical Psychologist and Psychotherapist. He works as Clinical Manager for Palier in The Hague, The Netherlands. The programs he manages include the Centre for Intensive Treatment; which specialises in adults with severe trauma, self injury and (chronic) suicidality; the Centre for Dual Diagnosis, which treats adult patients with a severe mental illness and substance abuse disorder; Weerlanden, a program for patients with intellectual disability, substance

abuse disorder and forensic background; and an outpatient facility for adult survivors of abuse and neglect prior to age 7.

Mr. Bloemendaal studied at the University of Leiden, receiving his Master Degree in 1999. From 2004 until 2010 he trained for his Doctorate in Clinical Psychology and Psychotherapy in Rotterdam. He is currently working on his PhD dissertation to study whether NMT-based interventions contribute to improving the treatment success rates of patients with a severe mental illness, trauma/neglect and/or substance abuse disorders, and his area of expertise lies in adults with treatment refractory psychopathology, survivors of trauma and neglect and chronic suicidality.

In addition, Mr. Bloemendaal maintains a private practise, is NMT Phase I trained and is working towards his NMT Phase II/TTT certification through The ChildTrauma Academy. He is also married and proud father of a son and daughter.
