NMT Training Certification: Brief Overview

The Neurosequential Model of Therapeutics (NMT) is a neurodevelopmentally informed, biologically respectful perspective on human development and functioning and is used in the clinical problem-solving process. NMT Training Certification is a training process meant to certify exposure to and participation in training activities. This training is a clinical enhancement, capacity building project providing exposure to core concepts underlying the NMT and to the clinical applications of this approach. The primary focus of Phase I training is to build comfort with, and experience in, organizing clinical information in a neurodevelopmentally-informed way; a primary objective of Certification is to develop competence with the web-based NMT Clinical Practice Tools (the NMT Metrics which yields Brain Maps). Participants are provided multiple opportunities to see multidisciplinary clinical problem solving using the NMT approach in many case-based staffings that are part of the learning process.

The majority of NMT Training Certification is conducted via distance learning using web-archived materials that allow participants to work through the content in a self-paced and self-scheduled manner. The format is incredibly convenient. While this flexibility is truly welcomed, many professionals appreciate interactive opportunities to connect with their fellow NMT learners and practitioners. NMT Boot Camp provides this face-to-face learning experience.

NMT Training Certification – Phase I Boot Camp: Banff, Alberta, Canada June 11, 2018

The ChildTrauma Academy is pleased to offer a Boot Camp for our NMT Training Certification - Phase I Program at The Banff Centre in Banff, Alberta, Canada on Monday, June 11, 2018 with specified tracks to follow within the schedule of the 3rd International Neurosequential Model Symposium the following three days. Limited to 30 participants, this Boot Camp is a live, face-to-face learning experience led by Dr. Bruce Perry, NMT Trainers and Mentors, and CTA Fellows.

This NMT Phase I Boot Camp is offered as an adjunct opportunity at The 3rd International Neurosequential Model Symposium which is also taking place at the Banff

Centre in Banff, Alberta June 12 – 14, 2018. The NMT Boot Camp will include a full-day training on Monday, June 11, and participants will then attend a specific boot camp track session offered every afternoon Tuesday – Thursday, June 12 – 14th as part of the Symposium schedule. Through their Boot Camp registration, participants will automatically be registered to attend the full Symposium. A Boot Camp Only registration is not possible in this case. Please note that participants must bring their own laptop computers to Boot Camp.

NMT Training Certification – Phase I Curriculum:

The ChildTrauma Academy's NMT Training Certification Program combines live and self-directed learning opportunities in Phase I. Phase I Training is organized into 12 training "modules" plus 2 reflection "modules", and a provided training guide articulates all required activities for each module. Participants will typically spend 15 months year gradually working through the content. Required curricular elements are outlined briefly below:

1. Multimedia Content:

Includes CTA DVD and Multimedia content, recorded presentations, CTA YouTube Channel Seven Slide Series sessions, etc.

2. Readings

Package of required readings include syllabus of 35+ professional articles.

3. NMT Core Certification Series Recordings

View 20+ hours of Introductory and Core NMT Case-based teaching conferences

4. Case-based Seminars: Recordings of the CTA's Friday NMT Case-based Training Series

View recordings of one complete NMT Case-based Training Series (15 hours)

5. Learning Community Discussions and Study Group Participation

Participants join a monthly, 1 hour Study Group call led by NMT Trainers and Mentors

6. NMT Online Clinical Practice Tools (aka the NMT Metrics or Brain Maps)

Access to and ample practice with NMT Online Clinical Practice Tools to allow each participant to become familiar with the NMT metrics. Participants also view Metric Tool Fidelity Scoring calls and participate in bi-annual Fidelity Exercises.

The NMT Phase I Boot Camp, conducted in retreat style fashion, is a terrific way for participants to jump-start their Certification process and provides clinicians with opportunities for in-person learning and relationship-building.

Once Phase I Training is completed, clinicians join a worldwide network of NMT Trained providers who share best practices on an ongoing basis and may elect to move on to Phase II/Train-the-Trainer (TTT) directly or enroll in the Maintenance Phase.

The total registration cost for this NMT Phase I Boot Camp including the full NMT Training Certification - Phase I Program and materials is \$4500 USD.
